

Open House FAQs!

Where is parking/Is it free to park?

Parking is free during Open House (October 25, 2025). Guests have been advised to park in lot E or F.

Where is check-in/registration?

From 8:30 am – 11 am, it will be in Anderson Hall and/or Andy's Place (AH100).

From 11 am – 3pm, it will be at the PE Ticket Booth across from Tim Hortons.

Do I have to check-in?

Please! To be eligible for the \$1,000 tuition credit draw or enter the draw for one of the guaranteed housing offers, guests must apply for admission AND check-in on Eventbrite. There are also multiple other draws that require checking-in (but not applying for admission).

Can I arrive late?

Absolutely! Check-in goes until 3 pm. Guests can check in remotely by emailing kit.sibbet@uleth.ca during the event.

Where can I find the schedule?

What is “on the spot admission”?

In Anderson Hall (AH147), you can apply for admission and be accepted on the spot if you meet all of the requirements! This runs from 9 am - 3 pm.

Please note that application fees (\$140) still apply.

What do I need to apply for admission?

For Albertans, just a credit or debit card to pay the application fee (\$140).

Students coming from out of province will need to provide their high school transcripts (official or unofficial). If they have access to their grades online, such as Power School, they can get their unofficial transcripts that way.
